Junior Assistant Scoutmaster

General Information

- Type - Appointed by Scoutmaster
Term - until 18th Birthday
Reports to - Scoutmaster
Description - The Junior Assistant Scoutmaster serves in the capacity of an Assistant Scoutmaster except where legal age and maturity are required. He must be at least 16 years old but not yet 18. He's appointed by the scoutmaster because of his leadership ability.
Comments - In many cases the JSAM has the same responsibilities as an Assistant Scoutmaster.

Qualifications

- Age - 16
Rank - Life or Higher
Experience - SPL
Attendance - Must have had attendance of 75% in the previous 6 months

Performance requirements

- Training - Attend troop Junior Leader Training and National Youth Leadership Training.
Attendance - You are expected to attend 75% of all troop meetings, Patrol Leaders Meetings, outings, campouts and service projects. If your attendance is low, or if you have 3 unexcused absences in a row, you can be removed from this position.
Effort - You are expected to give this position your best effort.

General leadership responsibilities

- Uniform - Set the example by wearing the full scout uniform correctly.
Behavior - Set the example by living the scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show scout spirit in everything you say and do.
Attendance - Set an example by being an active scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the senior patrol leader if you are going to be absent for an outing and attempt to find someone to assume your responsibilities.

Specific leadership responsibilities

- Functions as an Assistant Scoutmaster
- Performs duties as assigned by Scoutmaster
